


However many of participants lost weight during our expedition... due to the healthy good foods & daily activities

Scott mingles well with the locals, they warmly welcome our western visitors...








At dusk, we were welcomed into this historical mosque, experiencing together with the local Muslims for the Ramadan beginning celebration...

We reached the little town – Tingri, prepare for our next day's journey to the basecamp...


And settled in this still comfortable hotel, at 4,300 meter altitude...

After back down from as high as 5,600m, on route we are towards Gyantse...














Maintain a healthy, fresh, tasty nutritious diet is a Important task for our expedition...

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Gyantse, an important town with long history & strategy location... we are here now...










Before sun rising, Kirk and Nikki have been following me Taiji under the Gyantse Fortress... 👍

A less than 2-hrs flight from Lhasa took us from the "Shangri-La" to the busy, hectic, dusty, chaotic and congested Kathmandu...






Into Nepal arrived in Kathmandu 抵达尼泊尔的加德满都




